

<u>GitHub Integration – Workstation</u>

Brief Overview

The GitHub integration allows developers to access and manage their GitHub repositories and open pull requests directly from Workstation.

Capabilities

- GitHub Search: The integration can search for Repositories and Open Pull Requests
- **GitHub Widget:** The Widget includes open Pull Requests only. The list display is identical to the one we have with Recent Search Results

Enable GitHub in Console

- 1. Navigate to the **<u>Workstation Integrations page</u>** in the console
- 2. Search for **GitHub**
- 3. Click Enable



4. The integration will appear in the Integrations tab of the app's Settings

Segmentation

Integrations can be segmented to a sub-set of users and audiences, rather than being enabled for all end-users. This feature streamlines the integration process and helps to ensure that users are only using the integrations that are relevant to their work.

To segment a Workstation integration:

1. Navigate to the **<u>Workstation Integrations page</u>** in the console

- 4. Select the audiences or individual users from the dropdowns to handpick who can use the integration
