

Deploy WalkMe Using an Extension

Brief Overview

If you cannot access your website/application's HTML, or prefer not to manually alter it for any reason, you can deploy the WalkMe extension on your users' browsers, which will insert the [WalkMe snippet](#) into the HTML of the relevant pages.

Below is the step-by-step guide on how to do it.

Deployment Guide

1. Access the Admin Center

Expand


Log in to the Admin Center at admin.walkme.com If you don't have permission, ask your Administrator to provide it.

Note: Access to the Admin Center is provided to WalkMe customers.

2. Navigate to the installation section

Expand

Open the installation section in the Admin Center.



3. Enter the installation wizard

Expand

To download the extension file, click on **Open Installation Wizard** and follow the instructions in the installation section.

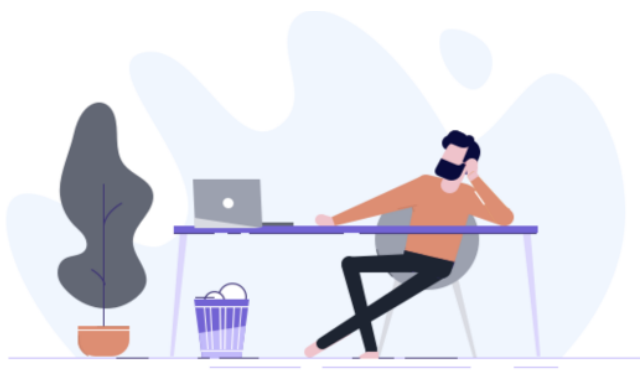

WalkMe Extension

The Player Extension is an option for customers that are unable to paste the code directly into the source code of their site. The Player Extension is installed locally on each user's browser and injects the Snippet into the code of each page that is loaded. This deployment is accomplished using automation scripts and built-in deployment features which allow your IT team to enable the WalkMe extension on your end-users' browsers.

4. Locate the downloaded extension file

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After downloading the extension file, find it on your computer. The file will have a specific format (e.g., .crx, .xpi).

5. Install the extension

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1. Open your web browser
2. Find the extension file you downloaded
3. Drag and drop the extension file into the browser window
4. If a pop-up window appears, click "Add" or "Install" to confirm the installation

6. Confirm the installation

Expand

Look for the extension icon or a new menu option in your browser's toolbar.

This indicates that the extension has been successfully installed.



7. Use the extension

Expand

Click on the extension icon or navigate to the newly added menu option in your browser's toolbar to access the extension features.
