- Toggle between capturing regular steps and automated steps
- Seamlessly record an entire process by using Quick Record (Coming soon)

Outgoing Webhooks



API integrations are often resource-intensive and capped by 3rd party tools, making you wait for important data. With webhooks, you can integrate real-time WalkMe Events into your 3rd party tools, so your teams can take action on time-sensitive information.

• Add real-time WalkMe Events to your Analytics/BI tool



- Trigger 3rd party APIs based on WalkMe Events
 - $\circ\,$ Get immediate Slack notifications when WalkMe AI predicts a user will churn
 - $\circ\,$ Add a user to a marketing list when they click a promotional ShoutOut
 - $\circ~$ Create a Zendesk ticket when a user submits a survey requesting extra help
 - $\circ\,$ Add users to a spreadsheet to track onboarding when they complete onboarding tasks
 - $\circ\,$ Receive an email when users complete an NPS survey
- Supports real-time outbound webhooks for WalkMe Events
- No development required, use a simple setup wizard
- Securely transfers data using server-to-server calls
- Rename WalkMe Events for an out-of-the-box integration with analytics tools (by end of Q3, 2018)

• Restart Smart Walk-Thru Steps

Advanced builders, do you have a Smart Walk-Thru that branches into multiple subprocesses? Now you can just restart the same Walk-Thru from the beginning if all the sub-processes begin with the same steps.

• Spell Check in the Editor

As you type content into the WalkMe Editor, we'll now check your spelling just in case you make a misteak... I mean mistake. Spell check currently supports English and is enabled across all text inputs in the WalkMe Editor.

• Regex (Regular Expressions) for Dynamic Text

With Dynamic Text you can personalize a ShoutOut using text that appears on the page, e.g., "Welcome Back John.i@walkme.com." With Regex, you have more control over the text you use. Now you can drop the email and just say, "Welcome Back John." That's better, right?
